MONEY MATTERS WORKSHOP

Every day, kids are forming concrete opinions and attitudes about life and the meaning of money in their lives. Thrivent Financial for Lutherans and Zion PTL will be hosting interactive workshops for parents and kids on teaching money values January 20-24, 2010. Called **Parents, Kids, and Money Matters**, the workshop helps parents explore the concepts of consumerism, values, stewardship, and money choices. PSIA NEWS

Attention All Parents!! If your student is signed up for PSIA you will be required to sign up to help at the District Meet in some capacity. This includes judging and/or grading. We are required to provide one adult to every three entries (not every three students) and we are almost completely full this year. If you did not sign up for a specific area of duty I will be sending an email giving you an option. I will try to get parents assigned around the time your student is testing. This might not always be possible. My request to all parents is that we help each other supervise our children on the campus to make this easier for each other!

Final Assignments will be coming home this week. Please note that PSIA organizers made some changes this year to the grouping of events. 13 events this year were changed from single grades event to grouping grade events. For example, Calculator Applications was normally an event for 6th, 7th and 8th graders. Which meant 3 students from each grade level could compete. This year PSIA grouped those three grade levels together which means only 3 students total between the three grades can compete.

PSIA organizers explained that more private schools across the state are wanting to be included in competition. Testing at the state level was already too large. So to allow these schools the opportunity, these groupings are the result. **HERE'S THE KICKER:** This means that your student might or might not be signed up for each event he/she originally wanted to compete. Eliminations and moves had to be made to allow each student that signed up an opportunity. In some of the lower grade levels complete eliminations from PSIA took place.
