Amendment to Severe Weather Policy:

Due to the recent severe weather we experienced this week, Zion Lutheran Church and School is making a modification to our current policy. Please note that in all weather related decisions, Zion Lutheran Church & School will **plan** to follow the same schedule as that of the Georgetown Independent School District.

However, because of the location of our campus, we will reserve the right to make our own decision if the circumstances present themselves to us. If GISD calls off school, dismisses early or starts late, we will follow that same plan. With that said, Zion Lutheran may close school even though GISD does not make that same decision. We also may make a determination prior to their decision.

Fast Direct and/or email announcements will be given, when possible, if our school will be closed or dismissed early due to ice or snow storms. Also, as a friendly reminder, in order to be aware of the latest information coming from Zion, please try to make it a practice of checking your email or Fast Direct on a daily basis. Please feel free to call the school office if you do not have internet access on the days of severe weather.

In the event of the need for early school dismissal due to weather conditions, all school-related activities (including After School Care) will be cancelled. There will be school personnel remaining on campus until all students are picked up.
