### SECURITY ON THE ZLS CAMPUS

To provide our staff and students with a secure campus, all exterior doors to the parking lot except the covered church entrance will remain locked from 8:15 AM to 3:00 PM on school days. Anyone wishing to enter the Church and School campus during school hours is asked to use the covered church entrance which will be open from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM on Monday through Friday.

All visitors to the Church and School campus will be asked to check in and out at the Church or School office. They will receive a visitor's or volunteer's badge which must be worn while on the church and school campus. Volunteer groups who meet regularly on the campus will receive special badges identifying them as members of their respective groups. We ask all to recognize that the inconvenience this might present will be far-outweighed by the added security it offers for our student body, faculty/staff, and visitors.

Visitors will sign in and receive a visitor's or volunteer's badge to be worn when on the campus. Before leaving, visitors are asked to sign out and leave the badge in the office.

Parents should note that they are not required to sign in when bringing students in the morning or picking up students in the afternoon. The door to the parking lot will, however, be locked at 8:15 AM and will be unlocked at 3:00 PM.

Parents who come to pick up students during the day for appointments, etc. should note that the covered church entrance is the only open door during school hours. Sign out of students will continue to be done in the school office.

### From Mr. Glandorf, Just a reminder of the DROPOFF/PICKUP PROCEDURES

**In order to maximize the safety for all students, the following procedures will be strictly followed.**

#### Drop off before school

The safest way to drop off your children is the left drop off lane near the gym. If you are walking with your child(ren) into the building, park next to the church (see map for areas designated as walk-up parking) and enter the building through the covered entrance near the church. **Do not park under the trees and walk across the pick up/drop off lanes.**

Pick up after school:

Use the two lanes designated for pick up.

Remain in your car.

The teachers will escort the children to the cars. As the cars move forward the children will be taken to the first two cars in the line.

#### **Do not park under the trees and walk across the pick up/drop off lanes.**

Students walking into or out of the building with their parents must use the brown doors or the covered entrance near the church. Children leaving with their parents will only be released through the building.

**SPORTS NEWS...**1. Any student playing any sport(s) at Zion this year (INCLUDING SOFTBALL & SOCCER) must turn in the **purple and yellow forms** sent home yesterday by Monday, August 24! They also must turn in their \$50.00 sports fee if they are playing volleyball or football. A fee for basketball will be assessed later. **Turn everything into you classroom transportation box!!**

2. The "Athletic Handbook" for 09-10 is on the school website under quick links. All parents of players must read the handbook carefully before they return the **blue form** in day one stuff. This blue form should be turned in before the first league game on August 28. Have your child place this form in their classroom transportation box.

3. Football and volleyball jerseys will be given out Friday, August 21. All players must proceed to the MULTI-PURPOSE ROOM when they are dismissed from lunch on Friday. Players must take the jersey size they ordered last spring. New students and those that did not turn in a form will be sized as well as possible.

4. Girls will practice on Mondays and Wednesdays. The boys practice on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Practices are usually from 3:30—5 pm. **This schedule will begin the first day of school.**

5. Parents, please be sure to read the "Sports News" section of the Dragon Tales every Thursday for updates and changes regarding the sports schedule.

6. All volleyball and football players will need to provide their own solid red game shorts. These shorts must conform to the school dress code and be approved by their coach.

7. Zion's varsity VB girls will travel to Giddings this Saturday, August 22. Information with game times will be sent home as soon as it is received. Zion will have 2 separate teams for this event.

8. All VB & FB players will travel to Serbin on Friday, August 28 for games beginning at 3 pm. Volleyball and football games will be played concurrently. The JV boys and 5-7 girls will travel by bus leaving at 12:45 pm. The Varsity boys and 8<sup>th</sup> girls will carpool leaving at 1:30 pm.
