The safest way to drop off your child(ren) is to use the left drop off lane near the gym. If you are walking with your child(ren) into the building, park next to the church and enter the building through the covered entrance near the parlor. Students should not be walking into the building through this entrance without a parent.

Do not park under the trees and walk across the pick up/drop off lanes in the morning or afternoon.

Pick up lanes after school:

- Use the two lanes designated for pick up.
- Remain in your car.
- The teachers will escort the children to the cars. As the cars move forward the children will be taken to the first two cars in the line.

After school "Walk – In" Pick ups:

- If you are walking into the building to pick up your child, please follow the same procedures as in the morning.
- Again, please note: Students should not walk out of the building without a parent through the covered entrance near the parlor.
