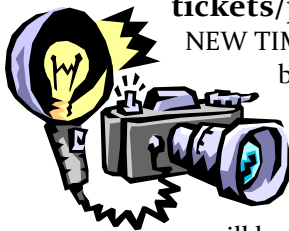
**5:30-6:30 pm Fall Carnival Pizza Dinner (\$1/slice)**

**6:30-8:30 pm Carnival Photo Booth (4 tickets/person) (K<sub>5</sub>)**



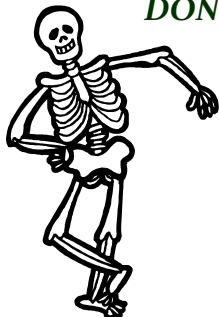
