

## 2011 Iowa Test of Basic Skills (ITBS) Composite Scores

Zion Lutheran School administered the National Standardized test ITBS in May 2011. The composite score describes our students' overall achievement on the tests which were administered. The composite percentile rank means that the students in that particular class scored higher than the percent of other students in the same grade level. For example Zion's first grade's composite percentile rank was 99, which means our first graders scored higher than 99 percent of the other first graders throughout the nation who also took this test.

Zion is proud to report that once again our students scored in the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile on the ITBS national standardized test. For the past nine years, Zion student's composite scores have been above the 90<sup>th</sup> percentile.
